2. Submit an exceptional personal statement.
3. Provide a copy of fall semester report card/grades (in lieu of, student may submit transcript through January 2020) and available SAT / ACT scores.
4. Provide a letter of recommendation from a high school official (teacher, coach, principal, counselor).
5. If any community service work has been performed, you may indicate such service by attaching a resume.
6. If selected to receive scholarship, please make arrangements to attend the Scholarship Awards Ceremony on June 18, 2020 at The Herrera Law Firm, located at 1800 W. Commerce, San Antonio, TX 78207. Recipients will be notified within one week of the ceremony.

QUALIFICATIONS - A successful applicant must:

1. Have at least a 3.0 grade point average.
2. Be a high school senior currently enrolled in an accredited secondary school.

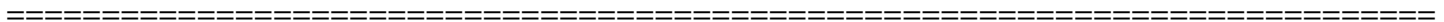
